Registered Kunekune Pig Sales Agreement

DNA/Registration

The purchased Kunekune pig is guaranteed to be pure bred. This animal has been DNA tested and certified to be of the lineage stated. It will be registered with the American Kunekune Pig Society (**AKKPS**) upon sale. Registration paperwork will be mailed to you by the AKKPS to the address provided above.

DNA will be mailed to UC Davis Labs when the piglet is 4 weeks of age or as soon as hairs can be pulled. After its return the registration paperwork can/will be completed with AKKPS. Both entities are experiencing longer than normal wait times. Please be patient. We are aware it can be frustrating and submit DNA as quickly as possible to avoid any further delays.

Deposit

Deposit is **non-refundable** unless the seller is unable to provide the pig(s) as agreed. The deposit may be applied to concurrent or future litters if the buyer forgoes the piglets in the specified litter or if the litter does not contain the specified piglet(s). Buyer's choice of piglets will be determined in order of deposit received. We will make every effort to work with each buyer to choose the perfect pig to suit their desires.

Transport

Piglets will not leave Carlisle Acres prior to 8 weeks of age. Typically they are ready between 8-10 weeks for pickup. Buyer will be notified when piglet is ready to pickup. Once the buyer is notified it is expected that the piglet will be picked up (buyer/transport) within 2 weeks. Adult pigs are expected to be picked up within 4 weeks of deposit placement. Barrows must stay until 2 weeks after castration before leaving. Should the pig need to stay longer there is an additional charge of \$3 per day for food and care. This must be paid in full or the client loses their deposit and the pig will remain the property of Carlisle Acres

The **buyer is responsible** for all transport arrangements and anything that may happen to the animal(s) during transport, including any sickness that may result from the stress of shipping. If a vet certificate is needed for transport, the buyer will be responsible for the additional charges.

*Transport and change can be stressful to any animal (especially piglets). Please offer them a safe, quiet location to adjust when they arrive. Also plenty of water and small meals to help them acclimate.

Health/Feeding

We raise our Kunekunes as holistically as possible but do believe in medical intervention if necessary. If any medications have been given to your piglet they will be noted on the paperwork attached. We recommend you find a vet in your area that you can consult in case of illness or emergency. If you have any questions about caring for your pig please feel free to ask us.

Your piglet will be sent home the food it is accustomed to so that it can transition to its new feed. Kunekunes need a balanced complete feed with at-least 1% lysine. Nationally you can find Purina Natures Match Sow & Pig Feed at Tractor Supply. We like to soak our feed in water to a mushy oatmeal consistency. This helps the pigs digest and get extra water in their diets.

We only allow pigs to leave the farm in optimum health. If there are any issues prior to pickup you will be notified asap. Carlisle Acres is not responsible for health issues that arise or occur after the sale of the pig. We are here to support you in the care and raising of your pigs. If you have any questions feel free to reach out.

Carlisle Acres does not guarantee that any pig will produce offspring due to husbandry at the new farm.

Herd Animals

Kunekunes are herd animals and do not do well alone. We reserve the right to refuse sale of any animals that will not be given a companion. As an option, we do have unregistered and registered companion pigs available from time to time at a lower rate. These are not breeding quality and will be castrated before they leave the premises. We also know many other Kunekune farms that also offer companion/homestead/pet quality pigs and would be happy to put you in touch. We have this rule for the health of the pig.
